The CAMFIN seminar has been offering for many years a great opportunity to bankers from our partner countries to deepen their knowledge in financial instruments and to benefit from the contact with Luxembourg bankers.

The House of Training has the pleasure to inform you that the Luxembourg Ministry of Finance will grant **up to ten scholarships covering the tuitions fees of this full board seminar.**

Two sessions will be held in Luxembourg this year:

**1) from 24<sup>th</sup> June - 01<sup>st</sup> July, 2019**

**2) from 7<sup>th</sup> to 14<sup>th</sup> October, 2019**

Interested bankers may choose between these 2 sessions as long as there are seats available.

We would be grateful if you could forward these documents to prospective candidates. Professionals interested are requested to send back their application form to your institution by 13<sup>th</sup> May 2019 at the latest.

We will inform you if the scholarships have all been granted and we have therefore stopped accepting additional international participants.

Once the participants are accepted and have been granted a scholarship, we will release the E-Learning session preparation (Part 1 of the programme) so that they can start to prepare themselves.

Please note that the selection process will be based on objective criteria such as the applicants' **educational and professional background**, their **present position** and their **level of English** (a good level of spoken English is required).

Finally, we will also send information about this programme to former participants who attended previous trainings and "International Financial Markets, ACI and Private Banking" seminars in Luxembourg or in their countries in the past and ask them to revert to you in case of interest.
